Stina Announces Commencement of Blackwater Drill Program

VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA – September 11, 2012 – Stina Resources Ltd. (“Stina” or the “Company”; TSX-V: SQA) is pleased to announce that Copper Creek Gold Corp. (“Copper Creek” has commenced a percussion drilling program on the Bandit copper-silver-gold exploration property located in the Blackwater area of central British Columbia.

Stina is funding this year’s exploration program on the Bandit property. Under the terms of an option agreement, Stina must incur \$2 million in exploration work over a four year period and issue 400,000 common shares to Copper Creek over a three year period to earn a 60% interest in the property. Copper Creek will be the operator of the project for the present exploration season.

The proposed exploration program will consist primarily of a number of percussion drill holes to assess the grade and extent of mineralization at the Bandit property.

The Bandit property lies approximately 130 km SSW of Vanderhoof, British Columbia. It is adjacent to claims owned by New Gold Inc. (NGD-T), where New Gold is currently drilling its Blackwater gold project. Blackwater currently hosts a gold resource of 5.5 million oz. indicated and 2.3 million oz. inferred (refer to New Gold Inc. March 7, 2012 news release). During the summer of 2011 Copper Creek conducted an extensive program of MMI soil sampling. This sampling uncovered a 2km x 5km area anomaly of copper, silver, gold and molybdenum. This area also shows as a coincident magnetic low on BC government aeromagnetic surveys.

The foregoing geological disclosure has been reviewed and verified by Kristian Whitehead, P.Geo. (a qualified person for the purpose of National Instrument 43-101, Standards of Disclosure for Mineral Projects). Mr. Whitehead is an officer of Copper Creek.
